THE COMPETITION

Terms & Conditions for the League:

1. Format – board allocation based on previous weeks results. For example, 1st place winners from each board goes to board 1, 2nd place goes to board 2 etc of the following week unless a player(s) cannot play or is not available.
2. Prize money allocations as follows:
 - a. player ranking over the 12 weeks – to be determined
 - b. First & Second place on a board per night - \$20 for first & \$10 for second
 - c. Most 171 or greater scores - \$50
 - d. Shortest Darts Leg - \$50
 - e. Most short dart legs less than or equal to 15 darts - \$50
 - f. Highest Peg - \$50
 - g. most tonnes plus finishes - \$50
 - h. Mid table Prize for following rankings for 8th and 15th places - \$50
3. Prize pool will be based on the number of players who participate. This prize pool may differ as it is only an estimate
4. To qualify for the players ranking prize pool (point 2a above, a greater than 50% attendance is required and a players must have club membership. The only requirement is that dart players need to be present on the presentation night or the first 3 weeks of the following competition to receive the prize money . Any prize money that is not collected by week 3 will be forfeited and allocated to the next competition prize pool.
5. If 2 or more players have the same result based on games won, then the 'legs won' will be used. If 2 or more players have equal 'legs won' as well, the winner will be determined by who won in the round robin. In the instance where this cannot be determined (normally 3 or more players), then players will play one leg 501 to determine nightly ranking.
6. Prize money will be shared if 2 or more players achieve the same result.
7. All moneys received will be distributed except for any incurred or future expenses by the Organiser(s).
8. In the event of a dispute/disagreement, the Organiser(s) will review the dispute/disagreement and have the final say.
9. Weekly entry cost to participate is \$10. This will entitle you to play in the competition on the night.

Approved Lending will also offer \$500 for any 9-dart finish



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
